Instrument Shelving and Drum Wall

Instrument shelves have been thoughtfully designed to be open concept for maximum flexibility. The top three levels of shelves are sized for popular mellophone and baritone case sizes and can typically accommodate three instruments across each shelf. The bottom shelf is available for other instruments. Drum wall shelves are designed to house your specific percussion cases. The Clubhouse does not recommend uncased drums to be transported on the shelves of the drum wall. All instrument shelves have been beveled back and are covered in an open loop carpet to add friction against the instrument cases. In most instances, there is no need to strap cases onto the shelves.

Shelves have a capacity of 75 lbs each. They are not designed to carry anything except instruments.

Maintenance:

- o Before and after each season, we recommend vacuuming the carpet.
- Before and after each season, check for loose or missing fasteners where the shelving attaches to the wall and tighten or replace.
- o Before and after each season, check for raised or loose staples in the carpet.
