

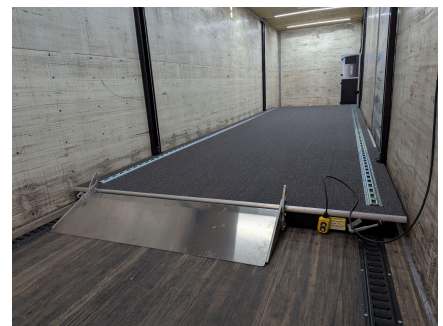
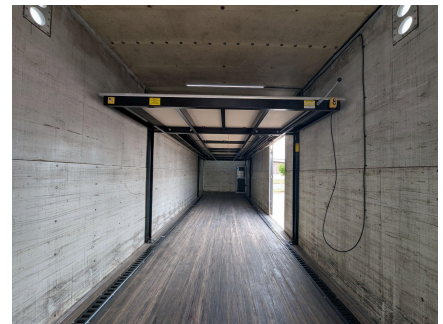
Flying Carpet™ - Powered Double-Deck Floor System for Dry Vans & Moving Trailers

For touring productions hauling lighting rigs, audio equipment, staging, and merchandise, that means fewer vehicles per move, fewer drivers to coordinate, and lower fuel and logistics costs — night after night, city after city.

The system is built for the realities of touring: one-button pendant operation, smart power configurations, and a folding approach plate for fast load-in. No complicated training. No extra crew. Just more capacity in the truck you're already running. Available for Dry Vans, and Kentucky Double Drop Moving Vans, our Flying Carpet can be configured in length to work for YOU.

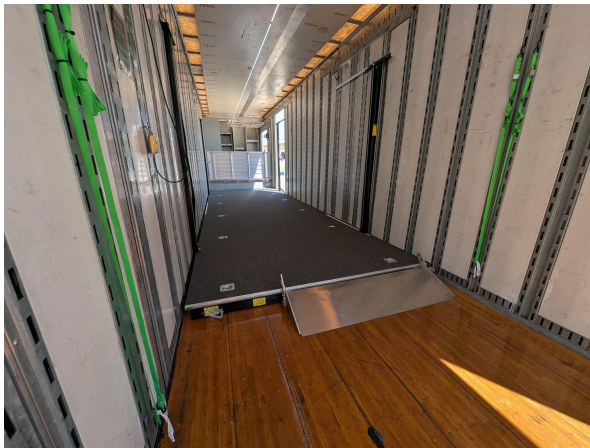
